Today about 1400 hours, [REDACTED] returned my phone call of yesterday. I explained what I was doing and that the only purpose of my call was to tell her that she had been given LSD by an Agency consultant, George White, in 1952. I offered to send her a letter if she desired, and she requested that I do so. She ~~complimented~~ complimented me on handling this contact discretely but said she resented all of the publicity this activity has received, inferring she blamed the CIA for it. I explained to her that the CIA had no surviving records on the activity and that all of ~~the publicity~~ information leading to the publicity came from George White's diary, now in the Electronic Museum at Los Altos College. She indicated the much of ~~the~~ embarrassment had been spared her because the press had not discovered [REDACTED]. I assured her they would not learn it thru the CIA.

Other points covered:

- A. I gave her [REDACTED] address and phone numbers and got her permission to give [REDACTED] hers
- B. She did not wish to discuss her reaction to the drug over the phone but ~~she~~ offered to do so by mail.
