~~(S//NF)~~ While the exact time of the visit is still being determined, staff employees are invited to attend for seating in the Lower Lobby and to stand in the Upper Lobby and Lower Lobby. There may also be a receiving line to meet the President. Attendance at this event is voluntary, and staff who attend the event must do so on their own time. Those interested in attending must RSVP by noon on Thursday, 19 January to [Redacted] on a first-come, first-served basis, and those confirmed to attend will receive a detailed response.
