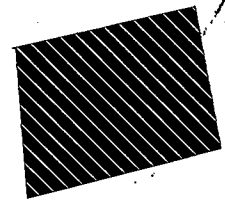

SUBJECT: International Commission of Inquiry into U.S. Crimes in Indochina (ICI), 10-26 October 1972, Copenhagen, Denmark

American Deserters Committee in SWEDEN

at the conclusion of the ICI hearings held in Copenhagen, Denmark, American groups organized by the American Deserters Committee issued a final statement under the heading "American Coalition in Europe for Peace, Freedom, Justice and Democracy" (ACE). The statement, which was anti-war in nature, contained the following addresses of groups participating in ACE:

E. American Deserters Committee, C/O POWERS NILSSON, Morsilsgatan 151, 16223 Vallingby, Sweden. (Comment: POWERS is probably identical with Mike POWERS; NILSSON is probably identical with POWERS' girlfriend Bodill NILSSON.)

F. American Liaison Committee in Italy. (Not further identified)
