- 0845 Col. Galloway called re contact in New York - 10/26.
- 0850 Col. Montague, Lt. Col. Haynes - request for clearance of Mr. Seager, Turkish expert, for staff of OR&E.  
Col. Montague - comments on latest British JIC paper (A-4).  
Called attention to cable regarding possible meeting of intelligence personnel to be held in Panama. Col. Wright felt CIG should have representative attend and would call Col. Solomon, G-2, with reference thereto.
- 0910 Major White, Lt. Col. Huston - re handling of USCIB, USCIC papers. To be handled directly between General Vandenberg, Col. Wright and Lt. Col. Huston unless papers get into Registry through normal channels.
- 0915 Major White - distribution of "black book" - with particular reference to items of interest to be sent to Admiral Leahy.
- 0920 Called Col. Solomon, G-2, with reference to cable reporting meeting of intelligence personnel. Desirability of CIG representative attending. Colonel Solomon will determine type of meeting and advise. Calls at 1010 and 1645 on same subject. Invitation is being issued to CIG to attend meeting and will permit two representatives.
- 0925 Lt. Col. Huston - request of General McClure for his transfer.
- 0930 General Vandenberg discussed with Admiral Leahy letter from Senate Committee Investigating the National Defense Program which requested certain information re CIG personnel, funds and operations. ACTION: Col. Wright to contact Mr. Meader, Chief Counsel for Comte.
- 0935 General Sibert and Mr. Weaver - personnel requirements of branch offices, commercial contact office -- particularly salaries and operational plan. General Sibert suggested trip to England for Weaver sometime in future to get British experience on this "sort of thing".  
Col. Wright suggested that Gen. Sibert recommend to the General that the N. Y. office be operated on unvouchered funds.
- 1000 Col. Shannon - Discussed need for two people of "Inspector General" type with personnel experience -- one to investigate Washington office and other to go overseas. Suggested people like Cols. Hanson and Taylor of Manpower Bd.  
Discussed Mr. Kennan's assignment. Mr. Kennan is to prepare plan for contacting "key" people for OR&E.
