Personnel Branch, A&M, advised that [redacted] had been offered a job with Special Funds; applicant was to indicate today whether or not she was interested.

Col. Galloway reference I&S inspections of SO stations and activities.

Capt. McCollum reference Army statement of concurrence on SR-26 [redacted]. The Deputy Director checked with [redacted] G-2, concerning his statement of concurrence and it was agreed that it was only necessary to use the first sentence of the Army concurrence.



 ICAPS, reference publication of unclassified list of committees on which State Department has membership--having particular reference to IAC.


