Mr. Dulles reported that the President has initialled the psychological warfare directive but will not sign it until he finds the appropriate Director. The Director said that he had passed on his list of candidates to the President, and Mr. Dulles said that he had given a list to Admiral Souers.

Mr. Dulles reported that he had received the study on which the Director had requested, but pointed out that the NSC meeting for this week had been postponed.

Mr. Jackson reported that an estimate of the atomic energy situation was being prepared for the President and that it had been in the works at the time that it was requested.

Mr. McConnel reported that Mr. Bunker had been named Ambassador to the Argentine and that it might be appropriate to have a luncheon for him and to brief him. In this connection the Director stated that he wanted one man to coordinate all CIA activities in South America.

The Director stated that he had decided that the Director of Training would report directly to him and indicated that a similar solution might be used to solve the Communications problem.

The Director announced that Admiral Bieri had accepted an appointment to the Board of Estimates.
