Mr. Reber reported that he had set up talks with G-2 and A-2 on evaluations. He said that we wanted G-2 to evaluate approximately 350 out of 800 0/S0 reports each month and some 50 0/O reports each month, and that we wanted A-2 to evaluate 150 0/SO reports and 35 0/O reports.

Mr. Kirkpatrick reported his discussion with Mr. Babbitt of Civil Defense and said that a memorandum for the record would be prepared and circulated to the appropriate Assistant Directors.

Mr. Kirkpatrick asked Mr. Hunt to make sure that a report on the Panama situation was prepared for dissemination to the Secretary of Defense, the White House, and a sterilized version to Congressman Anfuso.

 $\,$ Mr. Reber reported that he was holding a meeting on requirements and that Mr. Eckel of O/CI had prepared a statement on covert requirements.
