Mr. Jackson reported that he had talked to Admiral Souers about Gordon Gray and that the latter was coming to Washington this week to see the President.

Mr. Jackson reported that Armstrong had written on a matter that seemed to be primarily administrative. The Director stated that we should take up the matter directly with Humelsine. The Director said further that before we made any statement supporting Armstrong's budget we should find out what he is doing that should be done.
