Director's Meeting

Thursday, 28 June 1951

Mr. Dulles raised the question of the deception operation in [redacted]
It was agreed that the Director would talk to [redacted] and that [redacted] would
then see Gen. Twining in the Air Force.

There was discussion of a candidate for [redacted] The Director
said that he was still hopeful of getting Willoughby and if not Willoughby
he suggested Col. King.

The Director asked what we did with the Communist agents who
had penetrated our training area [redacted]

Mr. Dulles asked why O/PC had not put the training accident
in the log that he had told them to do.

Mr. Dulles mentioned that Armstrong was concerned about the
situation in [redacted] and wanted CIA to take action.

There was discussion of the position of Chief of Latin American
operations. Mr. Dulles said that he understood that General Sibert was
not available. The Director proposed [redacted] as a possibility.

Mr. Dulles asked whether there had been any reaction to the
proposed O/SI scientific bulletins. It was pointed out that these are
being circulated only within CIA at present. The Director stated that
we should be sure that material was desired by other agencies.

Mr. Wolf reported that [redacted] was reporting on Monday as the Senior Finance Officer.

[redacted] reported that Mr. Jackson had talked to Schaub of the Budget and had explained to him that we are relying on Armstrong's office for all political intelligence research.

The Director asked that there be a Deputies' meeting each Friday and that the PRC convene its hearings at 10.

Mr. Kirkpatrick reported that [redacted] was interested in what CIA was doing in the way of specific inducement of defection. The Director stated that [redacted] should be given any details that he requested. Mr. Dulles reported that [redacted] was to be employed as a consultant on his staff.
