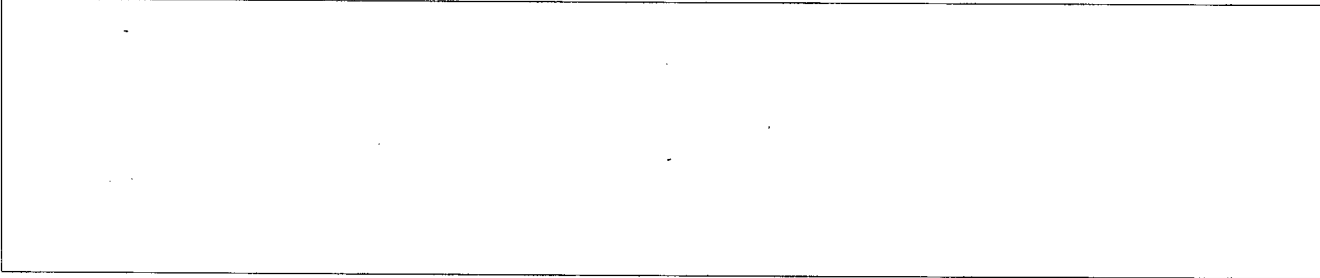

Talked to Mr. Carey about providing charts on FBID as presentation material for the DCI.



Asked [] to make up a flow chart on incoming intelligence. He will have a rough draft by tomorrow and the finished product the first of the week.

Talked to [] on new developments regarding the export of technical data to the USSR and asked him to brief [] for the NSC Senior Staff meeting at 2:30 today.

Talked to Col. White in regard to the best method of debriefing returning State Department officials, attaches, etc. We agreed that it would be impractical to have such debriefings recorded and given wide distribution as this in itself would tend to limit the remarks of returning personnel. Mr. Reber, AD/IC, will look into the matter to determine whether (a) it would be better to decentralize debriefing (State to debrief State officials, G-2 to debrief returning attaches) or (b) whether CIA should continue to debrief as a service of common concern but with the improved methods.

Mr. Kirkpatrick called for the purpose of borrowing [] papers in order to finish the letter to General Marshall. He subsequently saw Mr. Jackson.
