meeting will be held with [redacted] on this problem today, and it will probably be placed on the Agenda for the next IAC Meeting.

HR70-14

[redacted] discussed the status of [redacted] of OPC with PSB. Mr. Reber stated that it was his understanding that [redacted] was assigned as a Staff Officer to PSB in the same manner as other officials were being assigned from the participating agencies. [redacted] raised the question as to whether the several offices of CIA should be notified. It was agreed that if notification was made it should be done by OPC. [redacted] will follow through on this.

[redacted] brought up the subject of distribution of cables prepared by the Office of the DCI to the interested divisions of the Agency. It was agreed that [redacted] and [redacted] would have the responsibility for sending copies of such cables to the interested Deputies, who in turn would make distribution as they see fit.

Mr. O'Gara pointed out that CIA Leave Regulations provided for Compassionate Leave which is not chargeable to Annual and/or Sick Leave. However, in the case of an employee overseas, the present legislation does not provide for transportation to and from the United States.
