[Redacted] called in regard to the PRC. Wanted to know whether Mr. Jackson believes that developmental projects can go ahead on the authorization of the appropriate deputy up to the amount of [Redacted] without coming before the PRC. ~~He~~ will check this with Mr. Jackson.

Showed to Mr. Jackson Dr. Andrews draft letter to non-IAC Agencies in regard to the foreign travel of U.S. officials. Mr. Jackson believes that we should not write these Agencies, but that Mr. Reber should handle the matter. Have so advised Dr. Andrews.

Talked to Mr. Douglass in regard to our weekly cable to General Eisenhower. The DCI feels that our contribution is too small and insignificant. He wants to see a copy of the G-2 weekly to General Eisenhower and compare it with our own. Mr. Douglass will have a copy on Monday.
