Dr. Montague brought in the drafts for our part of the NSC 68/4 Paper. Showed drafts to Mr. Jackson and Reber is now circulating them among the IAC Agencies.

Set up Loyalty Board Meeting for 2:30 on Tuesday.

Talked to General Wyman and Colonel Edwards about the letter to USAF in regard to criticism by Colonel Wackwitz. Mr. Jackson signed the letters.

Ralph Clark called in regard to the Atomic Paper that Navy is vacillating once more, but he believes they will fall in line and that we should have a draft by tomorrow morning which I can show to the DCI.

Talked to Mr. Douglass about the weekly G-2 that goes to General Eisenhower. He tells me that his office has received from G-2 a copy of everything that they send General Eisenhower. This will all be sorted and sent up with a covering memorandum tomorrow so that I can discuss it with DCI.
