Mr. Jackson reported that from talks with Dr. Langer and Admiral Bieri, he felt that [redacted] would not fit in with ONE. Admiral Bieri will talk to [redacted] and we will be willing to release him to [redacted]. The DCI said that Admiral Bieri should look for a replacement for [redacted].

Mr. Jackson reported on a talk with Gordon Grey. Mr. Grey said that he is giving four days a week to his work at present but will tell his Board that he will have to work on a full-time basis for some months. The DCI said that it was imperative for Grey to find an executive assistant immediately.

The Director stated that he would get Tracey Barnes to come over and talk to him. He feels that Barnes should take the job as Grey's deputy with the understanding that he can always come to CIA at any time.

Mr. Wisner said that Senator McCarthy might precipitate a newspaper exposure on the 29 cases in the State Department awaiting Loyalty Boards. One of these cases is with us, and his name might possibly come out.

Mr. Jackson reported that Trubee Davison had talked once more to [redacted] who is now in New York looking for a job. It was suggested that the DCI see him on Tuesday or Wednesday of next week. The DCI feels we should have someone to deal with Air Force. Mr. Wisner stated that this had already been arranged and, consequently, DCI feels that we should delay action on [redacted]. Mr. Wisner reported that all interested departments and agencies are giving Mr. Grey at least one person under the "14 points". Mr. Wisner will find someone from CIA.

The Director stated that he will see General Willoughby on his arrival this afternoon. Mr. Stassen is coming in at about the same time and the Director wants Mr. Wisner to be present when Mr. Stassen is here.

Mr. Wisner reported that he had a long meeting with State Department as to our Far East policy at which the question of [redacted] was discussed. It was decided to concentrate more on the military and to
