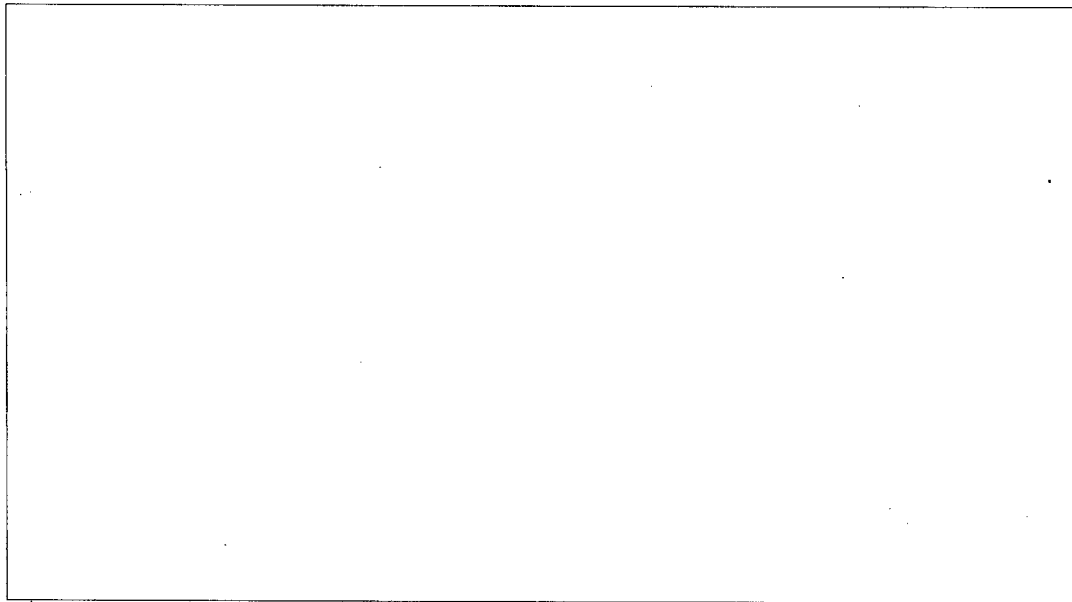
Monday, 6 August 1951

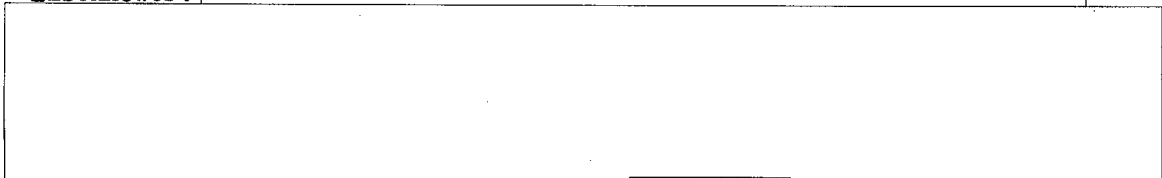
Called off Assistant Directors' meeting as there were no items for the agenda.
