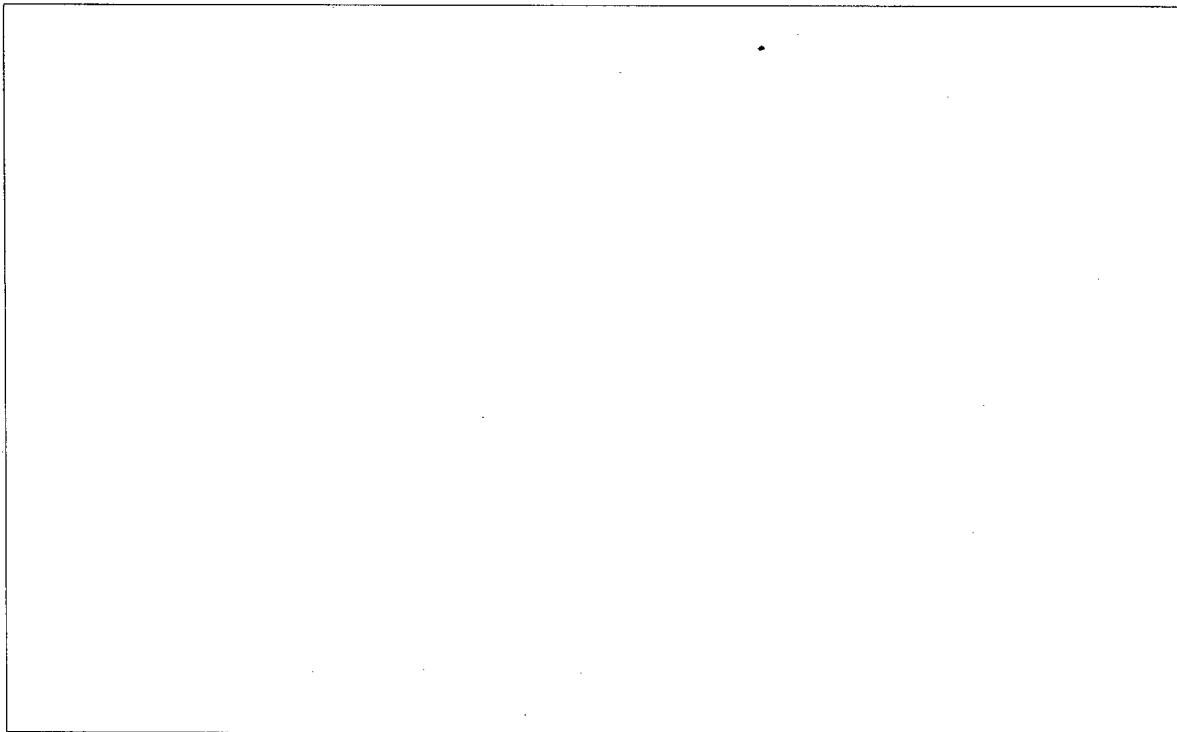

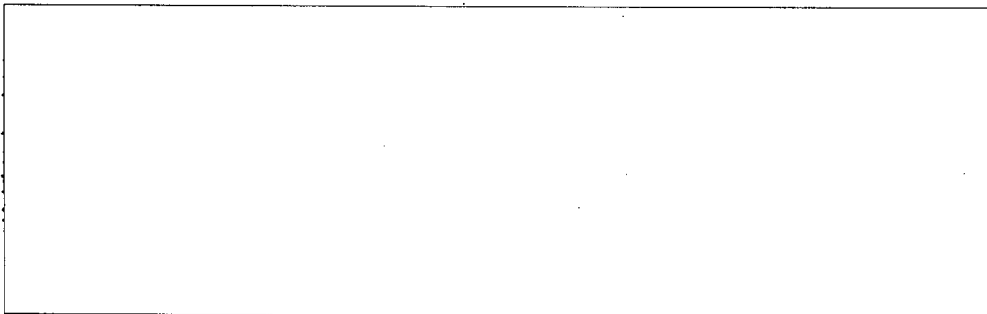
DAILY STAFF MEETING

Tuesday, 7 August 1951

[redacted] reported that General Gruenther had requested "all" CIA publications for General Eisenhower. At the present time Mr. Douglass is experiencing some difficulty in working out a method to transmit special intelligence, since this information cannot be sent by air. Mr. Douglass is working on this with General Bolling and will report the final outcome to the D/DCI and the DCI.



Mr. O'Gara reported that he and Colonel Denning had discussed the military personnel situation with Colonel Randall of Mrs. Rosenberg's office and it appears that the Secretary's office felt that the Services (Army, Navy and Air) should take the initiative of filling our military personnel requirements, while the Services felt that initiative in this matter was being taken by the Secretary's office.
