Friday, 17 August 1951

Mr. Wisner called in regard to the [redacted] He stated that [redacted] had been behaving in an erratic and vacant manner for some time and that O/PC had reported this to I&S.

Called [redacted] and told him that we would review his papers once more. I have promised to let him know if there is any position available before the end of next week. His home address is [redacted]

Conference with Mr. Sherman Kent and members of the Board on rewriting paragraph 8, SE 11, to conform with the thinking of the DCI. A compromise paragraph was worked out and approved by the DCI.

Talked to Dr. Chadwell about testimony of Mr. Caldwell (FCDA) on Russian atomic bombs before the House Appropriations Committee.

[redacted] of PSB called in regard to the type of intelligence that ought to be furnished as support for [redacted] I will check this and call [redacted] back.

Meeting with [redacted] of I&S and Colonel Hansen in regard to Mr. Caldwell's atomic testimony. I will ask [redacted] to come in on Monday at which time we can go over the question of security. O/SI sent to FCDA the desensitized version of the semi-annual report.

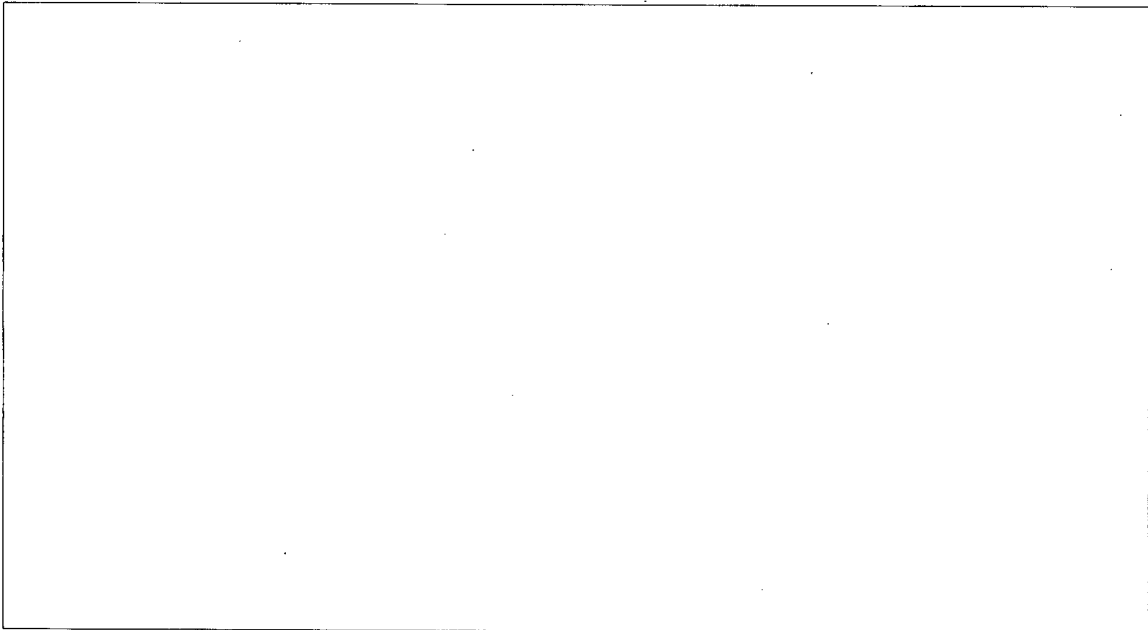
