DAILY STAFF MEETING

Tuesday, 28 August 1951

Colonel Hansen stated that he and Mr. Long saw Mr. Gleason regarding the revision of NSC 68. Colonel Hansen noted that NSC 114, together with other papers on file in OIC, will be of assistance in the preparation of this revision. A draft paper will be submitted to the IAC at its next meeting on Thursday, 30 August, at which time comments will be requested to be furnished not later than Tuesday, 4 September, in order that the final paper may be submitted to the IAC at its meeting on 6 September.

Colonel Hansen also stated that General Donovan had requested our file on [redacted] General Counsel and Security are working on this.

[redacted] noted that the DCI had been reminded to call General Twining regarding aircraft, and that he had also written a memorandum to Navy regarding personnel.

Mr. Harvey stated that Colonel Edwards is somewhat concerned over the security of our papers [redacted] Mr. Wolf has directed [redacted] and Colonel Edwards to work out satisfactory security arrangements with Mr. Gray's office.

[redacted] noted that the new system of debriefing [redacted] personnel returning from abroad would go into effect this week. Briefly, the debriefings will be conducted by the parent IAC Agency and not more than two qualified CIA people will attend.
