DAILY STAFF MEETING

Thursday, 30 August 1951

[redacted] noted that the second of a series of meetings to discuss a definition of "Psychological Warfare" has been called by State. [redacted] and [redacted] OIC, will represent the CIA.

Colonel Hansen noted that:

- a. Our draft comments on the revision of NSC 68 had been prepared and would be circulated to the IAC for comment at today's meeting. The final version of this draft will be discussed at the IAC Meeting on 6 September.
- b. Our comments on the Presidential speech "in case the peace talks at Kaesong fall through" are being prepared by ONE and will be submitted to DCI prior to return to the White House.

Colonel Taylor briefly discussed the organization of the office of the Deputy Director for Plans and indicated DD/P would have on his immediate staff assistants for Plans, Operations and Administration.

Colonel Taylor also noted that at yesterday's Consultant's Meeting, discussions were held on our relation with the Army,
