Mr. Becker stated that the DCI had received a letter from Mike Cowles, enclosing a letter from Paul Hoffman which recommended that General Smith be given sufficient funds to carry out a "strong" propaganda program. Mr. Becker stated further that the DCI thought it might be profitable for CIA to brief the heads of LIFE, TIME, NEWSWEEK and the three press services on some of our activities in this field. This briefing should be off the record and those present pledged to secrecy. Col. Hansen will prepare a suggested outline as to what should be covered. In this connection, Hansen noted that in a recent conversation
