Thursday, 13 September 1951

Informed Col. Stilwell that the Director would see [redacted] about 3 p.m., if it were necessary for him to do so. At the same time suggested to Col. Stilwell that O/NE and O/CI representatives be invited to social events for such foreign representatives, in view of the value that such contacts might have to the intelligence offices. I indicated that Stilwell might use his own judgment as to whether or not there were good reasons for not issuing such invitations.

Passed on to Mr. Warfield the request for preparation of a special report on Soviet broadcasts [redacted]

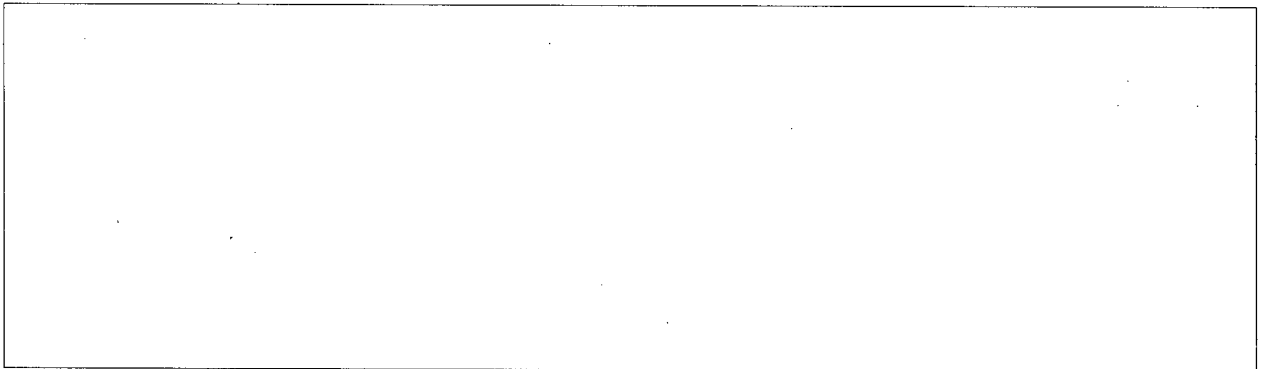
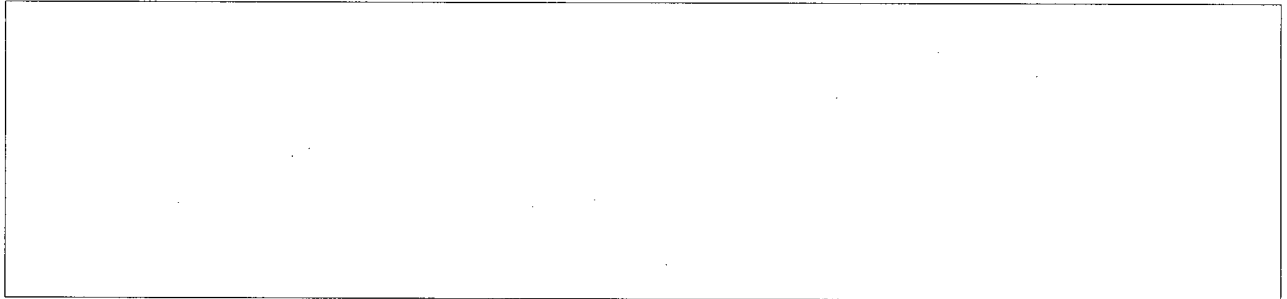
