The Director will not press for assignment. Whoever goes from Army, however, will have to be acceptable to us or we will send an additional man of our own. Mr. Dulles again brought up the fact that Mr. McCone is lunching with him today and will probably bring up the question of next year's Air Force budget In intelligence matters.
