Director's Meeting (Cont'd) 19 September 1951

Mr. Dulles reported on a meeting yesterday with Mr. Harriman, Mr. Gray, and General Magruder. They discussed Mr. Dulles' paper (?) which may be brought up at the next PSB Meeting. PSB should coordinate psychological warfare but not enter into operations. The DCI concures in this and feels that Mr. Gray is covering too much ground.

Mr. Wisner is preparing a briefing session sometime within the next ten days for and Mr. Gray. The DCI stated that Mr. Gray's office should restrict itself to drafting overall strategic plans and examining present projects to determine whether they are sound.

Mr. Dulles stated that Mr. Harriman was perturbed in regard to the Iranian situation. He feels that the British and Iranians each think that the other side will crack and has asked for any CIA ideas. The Director stated that we had exhausted our ideas.
