Mr. Dulles reported that he had been in a meeting at State Department yesterday in regard to Iran. As there were some 25 people present, nothing concrete developed.

Mr. Dulles reported on a conversation with Park Armstrong in which Mr. Armstrong explained Annex 3 to the proposed Bonn agreement. This Annex has nothing to do with intelligence. Armstrong will send over the papers this morning and Mr. Dulles will give the DCI a memorandum for discussion with Truscott.

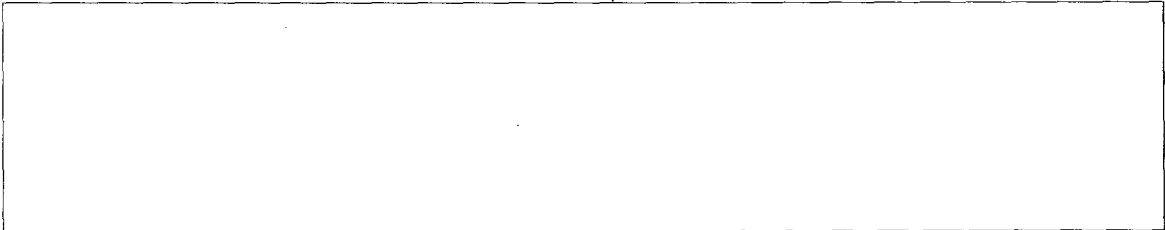

There was some discussion as to possible forms of assistance for [redacted] and Mr. Dulles suggested that we could possibly subsidize him in an amount of approximately [redacted]. The DCI concurs. This will be a personal subsidy for services rendered and will not go directly to [redacted].

Mr. Wolf brought up the question of possible employment of [redacted] as Head of the Military Personnel Division. The Director disapproved.
