## Official Diary

Wednesday, 26 September 1951

Talked to [ ] about couriers, the SO daily pouches  
and the [ ] courier.

Talked to [ ] about projects.

G-3 called to say that there would be a meeting tomorrow  
morning at 10 o'clock to discuss the [ ] problem. Have asked  
Colonel Taylor to advise O/PC and O/SO that we should be represented.

Talked to Mr. Becker about General Partridge's request  
that we send someone to sit on an ad hoc committee to draw up an  
estimate on Soviet and Satellite Capabilities for the Standing  
Group, NATO. This would appear to be entirely outside of the normal  
mechanism and I believe CIA should be present only in the role of  
observer. Mr. Becker will clear this with Dr. Langer.

Told Commo that they could go ahead with project [ ]  
as it had been passed by the PRC. It has not been signed by the  
DCI but I obtained Mr. Wolf's o.k.

Talked to Mr. Pforzheimer about whom we should deal with  
in Justice now that Peyton Ford has retired.
