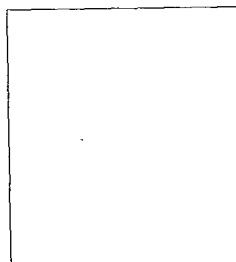
Mr. Dulles brought up the question of policy in regard to release of information on Russian atomic matters. Mr. Larocque said that as [redacted]

[redacted] it might be well to get suggestions from Gen. Cabell. Cabell's suggestions coupled with our responsibility for protection of intelligence sources should give us some guidance as to our future position in relation to publicity.

Mr. Wolf stated that both Gen. Wyman and Col. King were preparing memoranda on their Far Eastern trip.

Mr. Dulles stated that Mr. Frank Nash had told him that Governor Skinner of Guam wanted help in getting a Chief of Constabulary. [redacted] Mr. Wolf said that Col. Edwards had already discussed this with the DCI. Mr. Wolf will follow this up.

Mr. Wolf suggested that Jim Drum would be an excellent person for our Latin American desk. He will follow this up.
