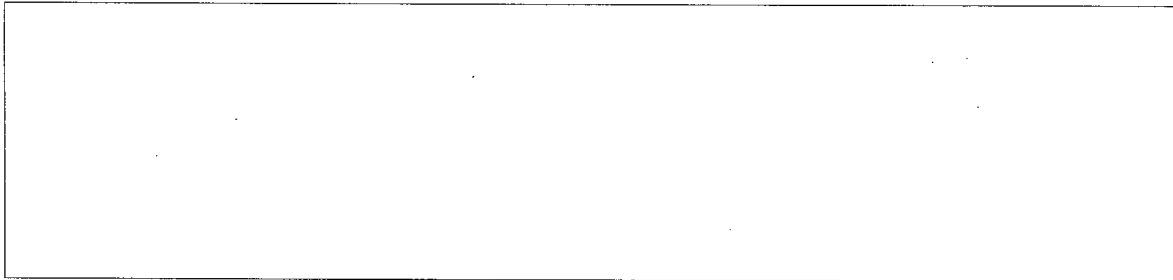
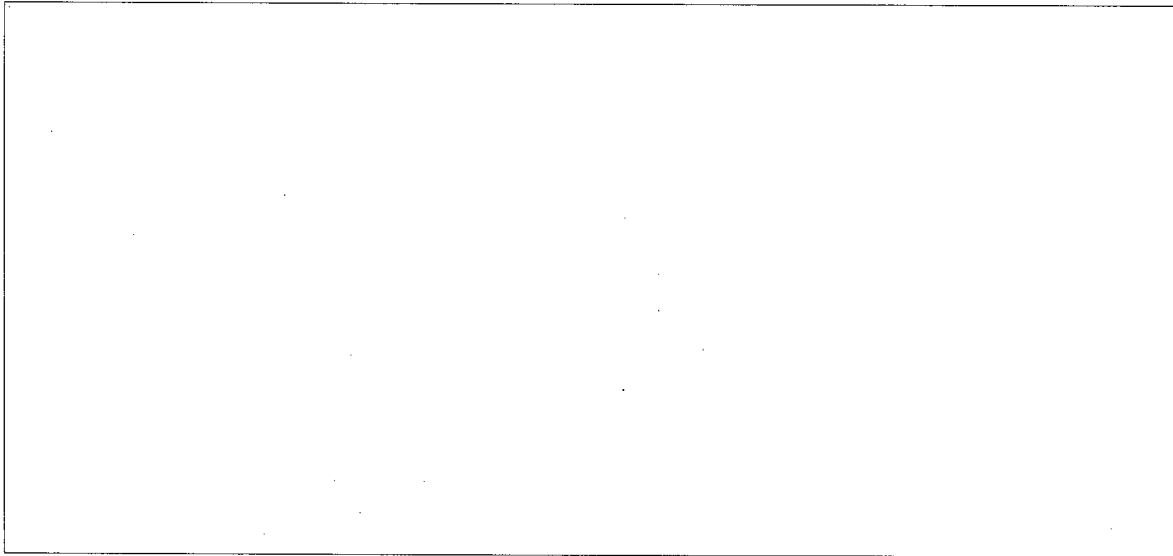

Mr. Dulles brought up a cable [REDACTED] in regard to the current situation. He again mentioned the committee of prominent Americans that he hoped might be organized. The DCI again approved subject to backing by the State Department.

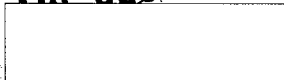
The Director talked to Senator Hayden and arranged that Mr. Wolf should see him about our printing facilities when he gets back to Washington. Senator Hayden believes that we should see "Let Freedom Ring" as he feels it approaches warmongering although produced for domestic consumption. The DCI will bring it up at the next PSB meeting.



Mr. Dulles reported that [REDACTED] was in Washington. It is doubtful if he will work with us but Mr. Dulles feels he will always be willing to do special jobs. The DCI would like to see him and will call him.
