Mr. Dulles said that there had been some question of as our Senior Representative in \_\_\_\_\_ He has been interviewed by both Gen. Wyman and Col. Johnston. Mr. Wisner will follow this up.

Mr. Wisner will call Mr. Bissel and get his reactions in regard to as an economist.

Mr. Dulles discussed Let Freedom Ring. He has told Mr. Barrett that it is not our business to exercise censorship over State Department publications. Mr. Wisner will look at the mock-up of Let Freedom Ring and give Mr. Dulles his comments. In the meantime, however, Mr. Wolf will tell Harrison that we cannot comment on such a State Department publication.

Mr. Wolf asked that Col. Edwards be kept closely in touch with developments in the integration plan. In regard to integration, Mr. Dulles stated that Gen. Wyman feels strongly that operations should be subordinated to intelligence.

Mr. Wolf has set up a meeting with Mr. Dulles and Mr. Wisner for tomorrow morning to go over a summary of the proposed 1953 budget.

Mr. Wisner asked about Gen. Willoughby's proposed trip. Mr. Dulles feels that he and Mr. Wisner should discuss this with the DCI immediately.

Mr. Wisner reported that he is seeing \_\_\_\_\_\_ tomorrow and will try to persuade him to come into CIA.

Mr. Wisner reminded Mr. Dulles that Gen. McClelland is going on a trip at the end of this week. He feels that it is a very good idea and will immeasurably improve the morale of Commo personnel in the field. Mr. Larocque stated that he did not believe the DCI knew of this trip and Mr. Dulles will mention it tomorrow morning.

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Mr. Dulles asked why we could not establish a courier service which would relieve the traffic load now being borne by Commo. Mr. Wolf reported that this was now being considered.
