Mr. Dulles reported on a meeting last night between himself, Mr. Wisner, Mr. Barrett and other State Department officials. He feels that some progress is being made towards the solution of the WOA, RFE and RFA controversy. Mr. Wisner stated that the political people in State are pretty much on our side and that things are becoming calmer. State still wants to take over the [Redacted] radio and expand their radio operations to the Far East. The Director reminded Mr. Wisner that he wanted a letter drafted for his signature to Mr. Webb.
