[REDACTED] of Communications undertook to have prepared an adequate summary of the recent Commo project calling for a large increase in FY 1952 budget.

Discussed with Ted Babbitt of Civil Defense the question of what type of intelligence would be furnished to CD in the event of the emergency plan coming into operation. This is a matter which can be followed through by Mr. Reber.

Discussed with Mr. Earman possible revisions of the Log and action paper summaries, etc.

Informed Kingman Douglass of a call I had received from [REDACTED] whom I had referred to Mr. Douglass. Douglass was familiar with the matter and undertook to carry through.

Advised Col. Drum of OPC [REDACTED] of the procedure to be followed in preparing a request for the purchase of certain devices which had not been provided for in this year's OPC budget. Both SO and SI are interested in this project.

Discussed with Mr. Davidson the discrepancy in estimates as to Russian aircraft production and arranged to chat with Mr. Kent about this tomorrow.

Mr. Hunt reported on certain contacts which OO had made with General Willoughby, all of which he planned to pass on to Mr. Muller.
