Mr. Davidson noted that G-2, FEC, had indicated in a recent report to G-2 here (with which they had agreed), that there had been an increase of 213,000 in the North Korean forces.

Mr. Harvey noted that:

a. ODM has been designated as a critical agency.

Mr. Becker briefly reported on a meeting he had with Ted Babbitt on 5 December, concerning a teletype center which FCDA wished to install in order that that Agency might receive direct ^{from} CIA - (1) information pertaining to an imminent attack on the U.S.; and (2) pertinent information after attack and/or attacks had been made. Mr. Becker stated that at first blush he believed FCDA should receive this information from Defense, since that Department had primary jurisdiction in this matter, and that Mr. Babbitt intended to call on the cognizant people there. After some discussion Mr. Reber undertook to explore this matter further with Mr. Babbitt.
