The question of preparation of papers for DCI to discuss with Mr. Churchill was raised. Mr. Becker undertook to bring this matter before the Deputies at this morning's meeting.

Colonel Hansen briefly discussed the two-horned dilemma which he was now on concerning the preparation of our Progress Report for the President. Mr. Becker instructed him to proceed along the lines outlined by Mr. Jackson.

Mr. Becker noted the lag in the delivery of intra-CIA papers, and asked Mr. Harvey to look into this matter with the possibility of creating a "red ball" express to speed along delivery of urgent papers.
