Mr. Wisner:

b. Noted that (1) the individual who had made a certain report in which DCI had expressed great interest was possibly being recalled; (2) there was also the possibility that this person might defect.

c. Asked the Director if General Ridgway planned to come to CIA while he was here in Washington. DCI stated that as far as he knew he did not; however, we should be prepared to discuss Clandestine Planning Committee activities with him.

d. Noted that Ramon's opponent was now claiming that the ballot boxes had been "stuffed" in the recent Panamanian elections.

Mr. Becker noted that he and Mr. Douglass had had very successful discussions with Gen. Bolling and Admiral Johnson yesterday.
