Deputies' Meeting

Monday, 7 July 1952

General Smith:

S 7.16-52

a. Directed that DD/A (1) expedite the installation of air conditioning equipment in the temporary buildings and such other buildings as required; (2) spruce up our buildings in order to make them more livable.

b. Asked Col. White to look into the matter of pay raises for [redacted] and [redacted]

c. Noted that he was seeing Gen. Ennis, G-2, FEC, tomorrow.

Mr. Wisner:

a. Noted the item in today's Log concerning [redacted] and stated the Department of State had asked us to contribute \$1,500 toward the expenses incurred on his recent trip [redacted]. The Director approved.

c. Left with the Director a cable containing a series of items from [redacted] which he believed would be of interest to the DCI.
