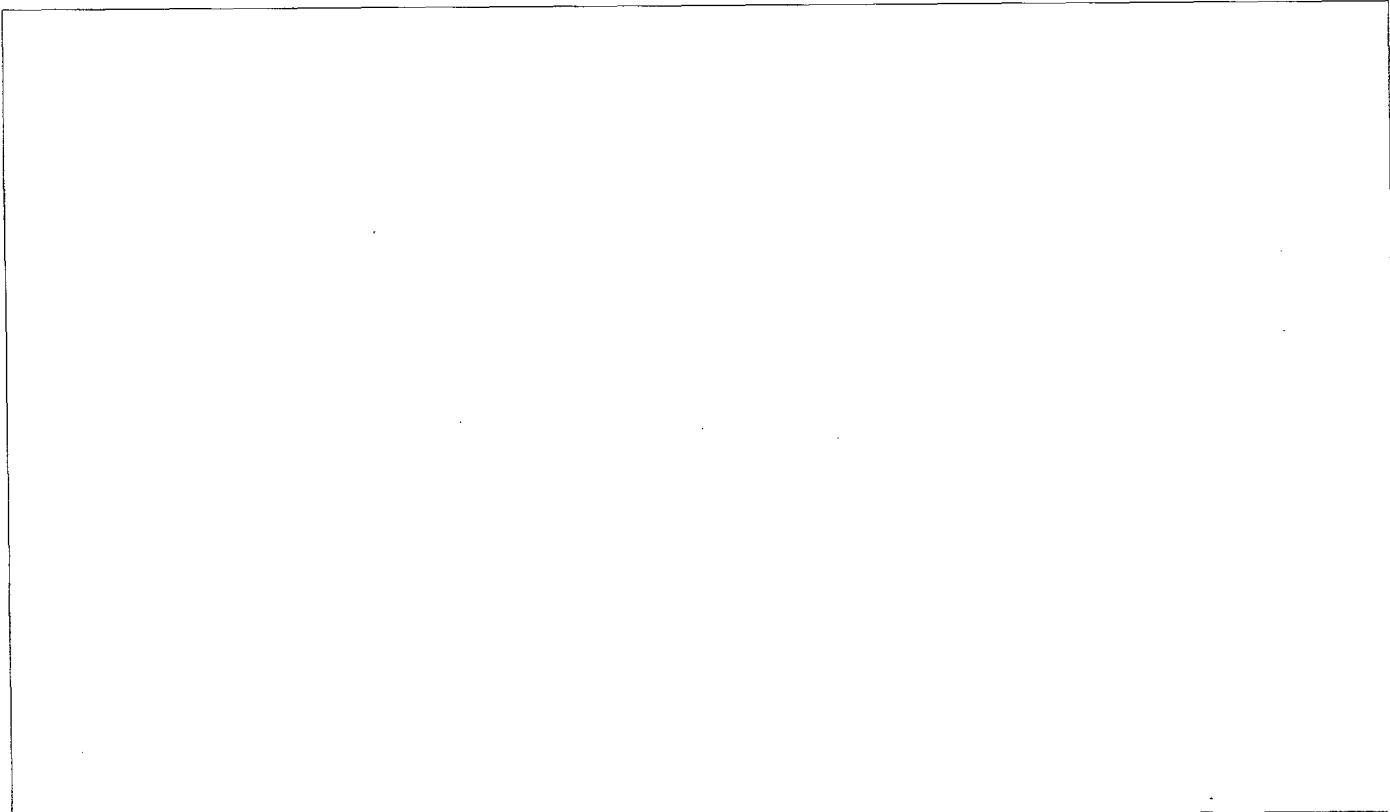
Deputies' Meeting

General Smith:



Mr. Dulles:

a. Noted he had received a memorandum from a certain individual which quoted a statement used by Stalin in 1933 at the time he was implementing the Farm Collectivisation Program, <sup>and</sup> at which time Stalin accused those who opposed this Program of using germ warfare in an effort to prevent its completion. The Director stated that if we could get the exact quotation and to whom it was presented, it was perfect propaganda material and should be used by every medium at our disposal.

b. Noted that Col. Hansen had requested that (1) he be released to return to the Air Force to accept a psychological warfare job at SHAPE; (2) he be sent to the field with CIA. After some discussion wherein a particular job was mentioned in which the Director felt that he could do if he would make up his mind as to whether he wanted to "go or stay," Mr. Wisner undertook to discuss the matter further with Hansen.

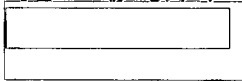

a. Noted that there was a briefing being held in the Director's Conference Room at 11 a.m. today on our [redacted] Procurement Program and asked the Director if he wished to attend.
