General Smith:

a. Noted he was attending a meeting of the Armed Forces Policy Council today and he believed he would be asked to lend support to the Secretaries' of the Army, Navy and Air Force proposed plan of aid to the Chinese Nationalists on Formosa. 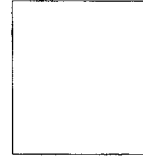
