

d. Referred to the working level State memorandum to Under Secretary Bruce concerning the establishment of the [Redacted Box] broadcasting station and, after some discussion, Mr. Wisner undertook to give the Director his views on this matter.

Mr. Wolf:

a. Reported that of the eleven loyalty cases now in the Agency six had been completed, four were awaiting return of interrogatories, and one would be delayed pending receipt of further information from the FBI. After some discussion, Mr. Wolf personally undertook to call on Senator Bingham and advise him of the status of the above-mentioned cases.


