

do about this since it was obvious that the Department of State wishes to hold Kennan as a titular ambassador; (2) however, if he should return for consultation, we would consider the matter further at that time. DD/P undertook to reply to the above cable.

Mr. Wolf:

a. Referred to the Bureau of the Budget's request that George Schwarzwald be cleared for our activities and, after some discussion, the Director noted that Budget had "agreed to keep him under control" and approved his clearance.

✓ b. Reported that most of the recommendations contained in Pat Coyne's report had been implemented; however, it would be necessary for him to discuss one portion of this report with the DCI. The Director stated that it might be well to have Coyne discuss his report before a combined meeting of the Assistant Directors.

Mr. Helms:

a. Briefly reported on the status of
