PRESENT: General Smith, Messrs. Dulles, Wisner, Wolf, Becker, Earman

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General Smith:

[REDACTED]

b. Referred to a cable from the Senior Representative, [REDACTED] and asked why we considered the security poor at Gen. Wyman's Headquarters. Mr. Wisner noted the reasons therefor as contained in the above-cited cable and, after some discussion, the Director stated that our Senior Representative in [REDACTED] should call upon Gen. Wyman to discuss this and other matters of mutual interest.

c. Reported on his discussion with Mr. Staats of the Bureau of the Budget regarding a new building for CIA and, after outlining his thoughts on this matter, asked Mr. Wolf to furnish him some additional information as a matter of urgency.

Mr. Dulles:

a. Noted the item in today's Log concerning [REDACTED] and stated that this information was inconsistent with the written report on this matter which he had discussed with [REDACTED] while in [REDACTED]. In this connection, D/DCI stated he did not believe that either [REDACTED] would "be thrown out of [REDACTED]". After some discussion, Mr. Dulles undertook to look into this matter.

d. Raised the question of our sending a retired officer of the Military Service to [REDACTED] and, after some discussion wherein Mr. Becker noted [REDACTED] the DCI undertook to call [REDACTED]

f. Briefly reported on a discussion he had in Paris on procurement for [REDACTED] and stated he believed we should withhold any further discussion on this matter with Secretary Lovett until after the election.

Mr. Wisner:

a. Raised the question of notification to the several field stations on the purpose of Mr. Becker's trip. The DCI stated they should be advised that "one of the Director's Deputies was coming as a representative of the DCI".

c. Noted that Ellis Briggs, the newly appointed Ambassador to Korea, was leaving for his post within the next week and asked the DCI if he desired to see him. The Director indicated that he did and asked to have Briggs come in at 11:30 a.m. on 5 November. [REDACTED] will coordinate this with Mr. Hulick.)

d. Cleared with the Director what he proposed to discuss with [REDACTED]. The Director noted that in any case we should not be too apologetic about the [REDACTED] affair.
