







f. Briefly reported on a discussion he had in Paris on procurement for and stated he believed we should withhold any further discussion on this matter with Secretary Lovett until after the election.
Mr. Wisner:
a. Raised the question of notification to the several field stations on the purpose of Mr. Becker's trip. The DCI stated they should be advised that "one of the Director's Deputies was coming as a representative of the DCI".
c. Noted that Ellis Briggs, the newly appointed Ambassador to Korea, was leaving for his post within the next week and asked the DCI if he desired to see him. The Director indicated that he did and asked to have Briggs come in at ll:30 a.m. on 5 November. Mr. Hulick.)
