


Mr. Amory:

a. Reported that the men he had sent to [ ] to set up a briefing room for General Eisenhower did not get expected cooperation from [ ]. Although Mr. Amory is prepared to set up a complete situation room, the Director indicated that this would not be in order but that a simple room in which briefings could take place would meet General Eisenhower's requirements. The Director said that he would talk to [ ] on the phone after the meeting. (NOTE: This call was completed.)

b. Reported that the IAC had accepted the proposal that a committee of scientists be set up for the further study of the flying saucer problem.
