

PRESENT: General Smith, Messrs. Dulles, Wisner, Wolf, Becker, Hedden, Helms, Long HR70-14 Mr. Dulles: c. Reported that the rate war started by CAT has considerably disturbed Pan American and Northwestern. Mr. Wisner: 5-1-20-53 a. Presented a memorandum recommending that we open up a "course of dealing" with in response to the note from Myron Taylor forwarded by the President. The Director suggested that a project be prepared along these lines and submitted to the PRC. Mr. Dulles noted that while we wish to avoid any purely philanthropic activity he considers worth helping. b. Noted that the Director was to attend a special PSB meeting on the Rosenberg case; he recommended against the President making a statement on the case but submitted a draft of a possible statement. The Director raised the parallel question of a Presidential statement on the recent U.S. thermonuclear explosion. After a call from Mr. Harriman, the Director instructed Mr. Helms to cooperate with
