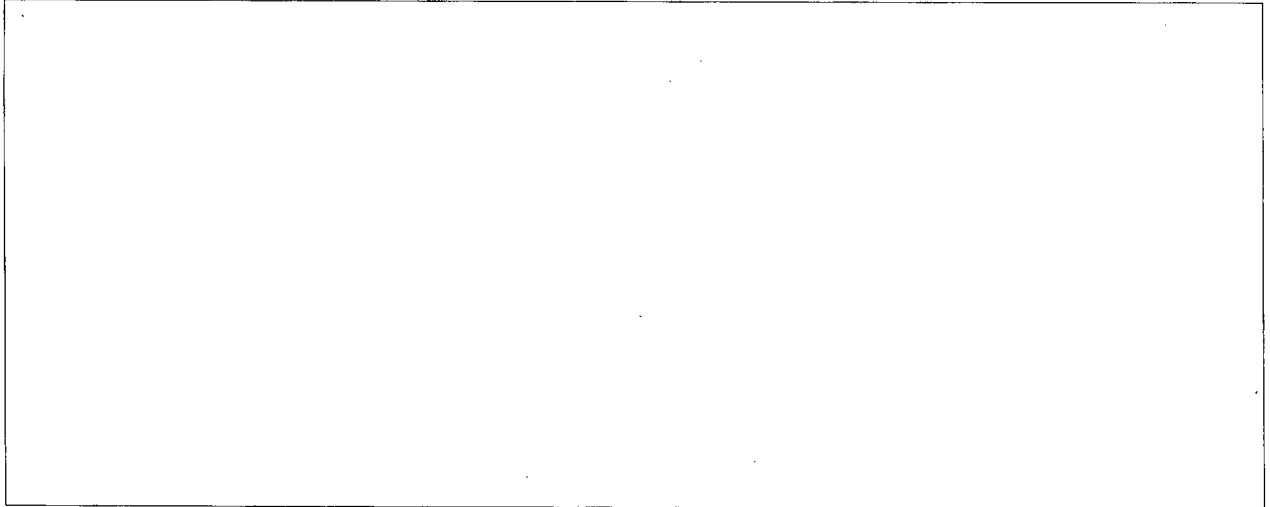

Mr. Dulles:



c. Reported that the rate war started by CAT has considerably disturbed Pan American and Northwestern.

Mr. Wisner:

a. Presented a memorandum recommending that we open up a "course of dealing" with [redacted] in response to the note from Myron Taylor forwarded by the President. The Director suggested that a project be prepared along these lines and submitted to the PRC. Mr. Dulles noted that while we wish to avoid any purely philanthropic activity he considers [redacted] well worth helping.

b. Noted that the Director was to attend a special PSB meeting on the Rosenberg case; he recommended against the President making a statement on the case but submitted a draft of a possible statement. The Director raised the parallel question of a Presidential statement on the recent U.S. thermo-nuclear explosion. After a call from Mr. Harriman, the Director instructed Mr. Helms to cooperate with [redacted]

Mr. Becker:

a. Reported there would be no IAC meeting this week.

b. Noted that the estimate of Soviet Atomic Capabilities was now completed and would be ready to lay before the IAC at its next meeting.

c. Noted a long State Department cable on the conversations between Ambassador Henderson and Mossadeq, and that these indicated some progress.
