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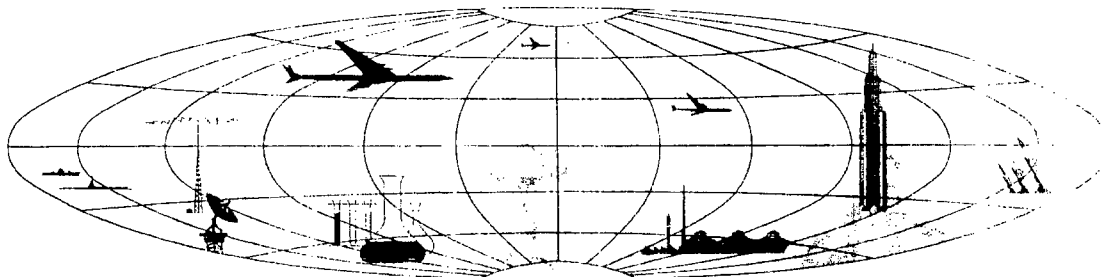
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PREFACE

This report is one in a series on Soviet Ground Force and Logistic installations being prepared for a DIA/CIA Panel. The series is being coordinated, published and disseminated by NPIC. The photographic analysis is being performed by the NPIC Photographic Analysis Group, the CIA Photographic Intelligence Division (NPIC), and the Production Center 1P1a (DIA). The photographic analysis for this particular report was performed by the Production Center 1P1a.

In the interest of uniformity, the titles and letter designators for the facilities observed at these installations are identical with those appearing in the project requirement. When a specific facility is not observed both its title and letter designator are omitted in the report.

Titles and letter designators for the various facilities are as follows: (A) railroad service, (B) road service, (C) landing strips, (D) administrative and troop housing areas, (E) storage areas, (F) ammunition storage areas, (G) POL storage areas, (H) other buildings and facilities, (J) equipment storage/maintenance areas, (K) athletic fields, (L) small arms firing ranges, (M) driver training areas, (N) tank/assault gun firing ranges, (P) flat trajectory firing ranges, (Q) artillery emplacements (batteries), (R) infantry or combined arms field training areas or courses, (S) special training facilities, (T) unidentified facilities or tracking activity.

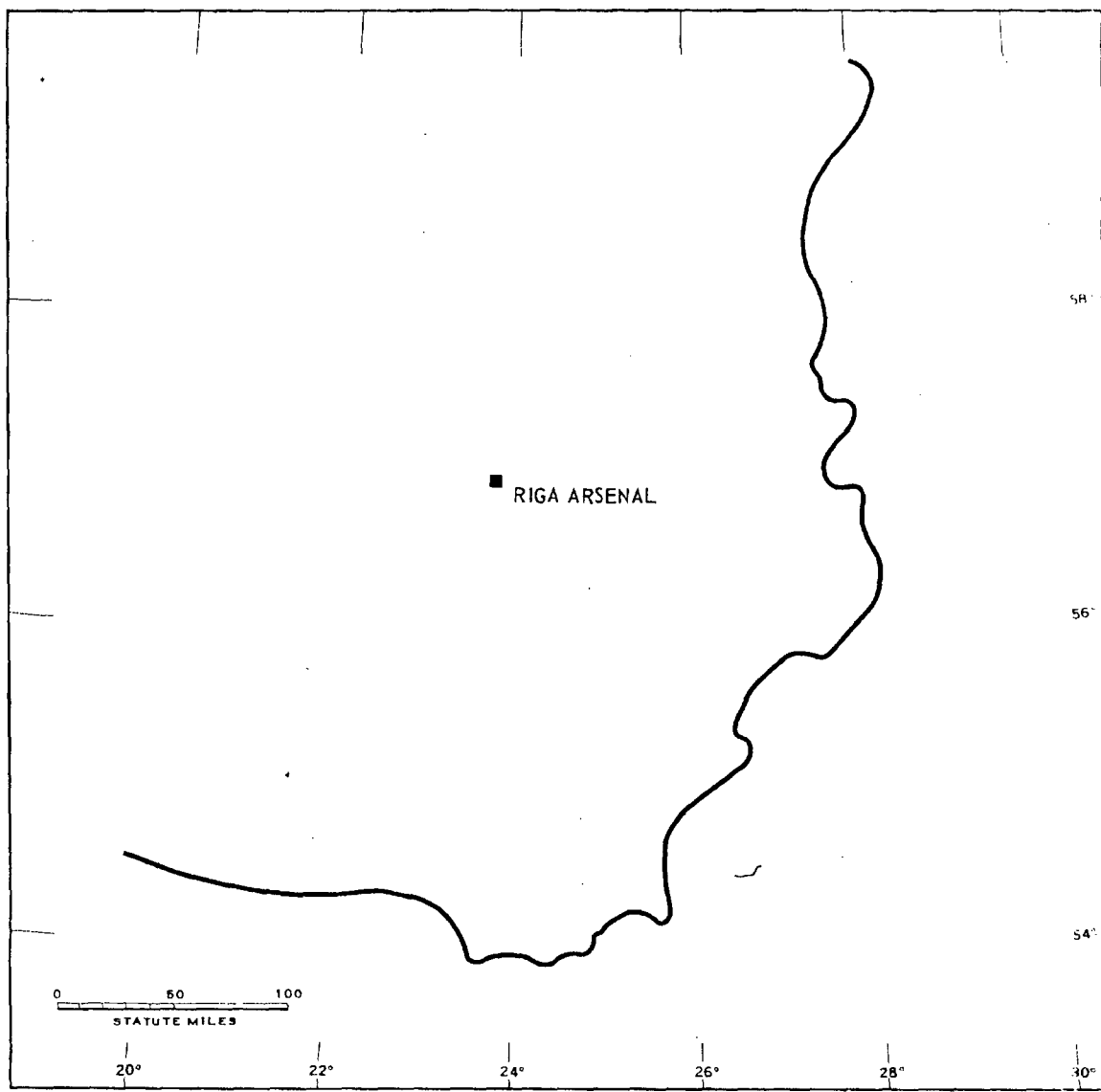


FIGURE 1. LOCATION OF RIGA ARSENAL.

SUMMARY

The Riga Arsenal is located in the southwestern part of Riga, 5 nautical miles (nm) east of the Riga West Airfield (Figure 1). The arsenal is secured. It covers approximately 45 acres and contains 34 buildings: 2 multi-story administration buildings, an administration/support building, 6 multistory barracks, 24 storage/maintenance buildings, and a probable motor vehicle storage/maintenance building

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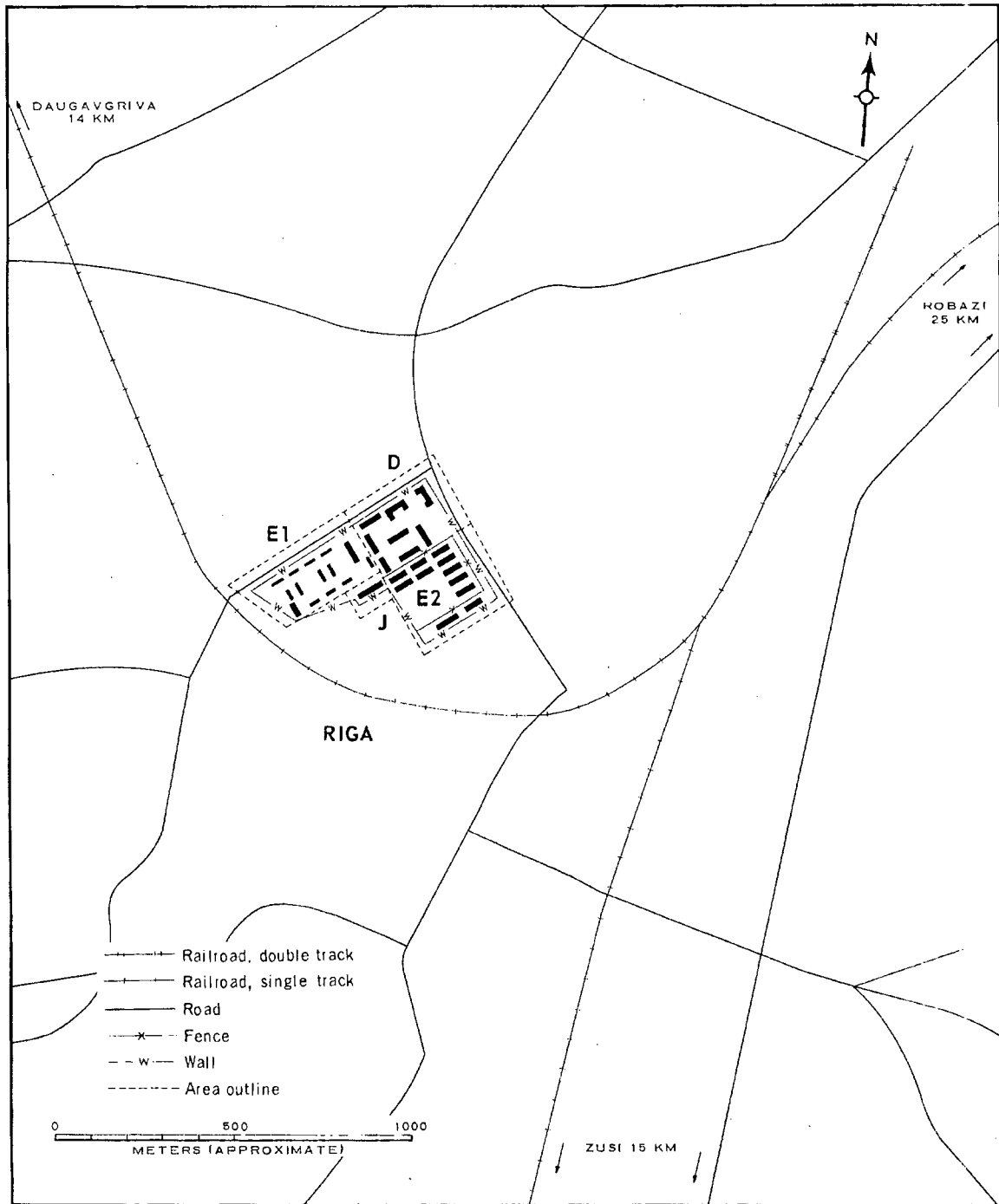


FIGURE 3. RIGA ARSENAL. Sketch compiled from Mission  July 1964.

(Figures 2 and 3).

This area was covered on TALENT photography of July 1956 and on 12 KEYHOLE missions between September 1961 and July 1964. The 2 administration buildings and the 6 multi-story barracks have been constructed since 1956. Since 1956, 5 motor vehicle sheds have been replaced by 5 storage/maintenance buildings, and an administration area has been added.

DESCRIPTION OF INSTALLATION

Railroad Service

A rail line is adjacent to the installation on the south.

Road Service

The arsenal is served by good all-weather roads.

Aircraft Landing Strips

The Riga West Airfield is located 5 km west of the arsenal.

Administration and Troop Housing Area

Area D contains 6 multistory barracks and 2 multistory administration buildings.

General Storage Areas

Area E1 contains 13 storage/maintenance buildings and an administration/support building.

Area E2 contains 11 storage/maintenance buildings.

Equipment Storage/Maintenance Area

Area J contains a probable motor vehicle storage/maintenance building.
