


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PREFACE

This report is one in a series on Soviet Ground Porce and Logistic installations being prepared for a DIA/CIA Panel. The series is being coordinated, published and disseminated by NPIC. The photographic analysis is being performed by the NPIC Photographic Analysis Group, the CIA Photographic Intelligence Division (NPIC), and the Production Center 1P1a (DIA). The photographic analysis for this particular report was performed by the Production Center 1P1a.

In the interest of uniformity, the titles and letter designators for the facilities observed at these installations are identical with those appearing in the project requirement. When a specific facility is not observed both its title and letter designator are omitted in the report.

Titles and letter designators for the various facilities are as follows: (A) railroad service, (B) road service, (C) landing strips, (D) administrative and troop housing areas, (E) storage areas, (F) ammunition storage areas, (G) POL storage areas, (H) other buildings and facilities, (D) equipment storage/maintenance areas, (K) athletic fields, (L) small arms firing ranges, (M) driver training areas, (N) tank/assault gun firing ranges, (P) flat trajectory firing ranges, (Q) artillery emplacements (batteries), (R) infantry or combined arms field training areas or courses, (S) special training facilities, (T) unidentified facilities or tracking activity.




FIGURE 1. LOCATION OF KAUNAS ORDNANCE DEPOT PUG.

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SUMMARY

Kaunas Ordnance Depot PUG is located just southeast of the center of Kaunas (Figure 1). This installation is 2 kilometers (km) north of Kaunas Army Barracks South. A primary road runs west of the depot and passes through Kaunas Army Barracks South.

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


FIGURE 3. KAUNAS ORDNANCE DEPOT PUG. Sketch compiled from June 1964.

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

This secured storage area (Figures 2 and 3) covers 85 acres and is divided into 2 sections. There are 1 administration building, 2 barracks, 1 probable vehicle maintenance building, 11 storage buildings, 2 revetted storage buildings and 1 possible revetted building in the main storage

area. The second area is located 1,500 feet to the south, and contains I administration building and possible open storage.

One TALENT and 5 missions of interpretable quality KEYHOLE photography between July 1956 and August 1964 were used in the preparation of this report. Comparative analysis reveals that 7 new storage buildings, I barracks, and a possible vehicle maintenance building have been built since July 1956. A previously reported barracks and 4 storage buildings cannot be verified due to poor image quality or foliage.

DESCRIPTION OF INSTALLATION

Railroad Service

Rail yards and shops are located 1,500 feet to the west.

Road Service

The installation has access to primary roads leading north, south, and west.

Administrative and Troop Housing Areas

Area D1 contains 2 barracks and 1 administration building.

Area D2 contains I administration building.

General Storage Areas

Area El contains II storage buildings, 6 of

which were not present in July 1956. Two previously reported storage buildings are not visible due to foliage.

Area ± 2 contains secured possible open storage.

Ammunition Storage Area

Area F contains 2 revetted storage buildings, each 100 by 65 feet, and I possibly revetted building, 30 by 20 feet. The previously reported ammunition storage bunkers are not visible due to poor resolution.

Equipment Storage/Maintenance Area

Area J contains 1 probable vehicle maintenance building, 60 by 30 feet.
