

Titles and letter designators for the various facilities are as follows: (A) railroad service, (B) road service, (C) landing strips, (D) administrative and troop housing areas, (E) storage areas, (F) ammunition storage areas, (G) POL storage areas, (H) other buildings and facilities, (J) equipment storage/maintenance areas, (K) athletic fields, (L) small arms firing ranges, (M) driver training areas, (N) tank/assault gun firing ranges, (P) flat trajectory firing ranges, (Q) artillery emplacements (batteries), (R) infantry or combined arms field training areas or courses, (S) special training facilities, (T) unidentified facilities or tracking activity.




FIGURE 1. LOCATION OF ARMY BARRACKS, USSR.

SUMMARY




FIGURE 3. ARMY BARRACKS. Sketch compiled from

This army barracks is located on the eastern edge of Kuressaare, 1.5 kilometers (km) north of the Kuressaare Airfield (Figure 1). The installation covers approximately 185 acres and contains 26 buildings: 6 barracks, 3 administration buildings, 9 storage buildings, 6 support buildings, and 2 vehicle storage and maintenance buildings (Figures 2 and 3). A probable tiving range is in the southeastern part of the installation and a small driver-training area is at the western edge.

A comparison of KEYHOLE photography of July 1963 and June 1964 reveals no significant change.

DESCRIPTION OF INSTALLATION

Railroad Service

A north-south single-track rail line passes through the installation.

Road Service

The installation is served by good allweather roads.

Aircraft Landing Strips

The Kuressaare Airfield is located 1.5 km south of the barracks.

Administration and Troop Housing Areas

Area DI contains 3 administration buildings, a barracks, and 3 support buildings.

Area D2 contains 5 barracks and a support building.

General Storage Areas

Area El contains 6 storage buildings, some of which may be for ammunition storage.

Area E2 contains 3 storage buildings.

Equipment Storage/Maintenance Area

Area J contains 2 vehicle storage / storage tenance buildings (160 by 35 feet and 100 by 35 feet) and 2 support buildings.

Athletic Field

Area K is an athletic field.

Driver-Training Area

Area M is a small wheeled-vehicle drivertraining area which contains a figure-8 course.

Tank/Assault-Gun Firing Range

Area N is a probable 1,600-foot tank/ assault-gun firing range with a 600-foot firing line.
