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PREFACE

This report is one in a series on Soviet Ground Force and Logistic installations being prepared for a DIA/CIA Panel. The series is being coordinated, published and disseminated by NPIC. The photographic analysis is being performed by the NPIC Photographic Analysis Group, the CIA Photographic Intelligence Division (NPIC), and the Production Center 1P1a (DIA). The photographic analysis for this particular report was performed by the NPIC Photographic Analysis Group.

In the interest of uniformity, the titles and letter designators for the facilities observed at these installations are identical with those appearing in the project requirement. When a specific facility is not observed both its title and letter designator are omitted in the report.

Titles and letter designators for the various facilities are as follows: (A) railroad service, (B) road service, (C) landing strips, (D) administrative and troop housing areas, (E) storage areas, (F) ammunition storage areas, (G) POL storage areas, (H) other buildings and facilities, (J) equipment storage/maintenance areas, (K) athletic fields, (L) small arms firing ranges, (M) driver training areas, (N) tank/assault gun firing ranges, (P) flat trajectory firing ranges, (Q) artillery emplacements (batteries), (R) infantry or combined arms field training area or courses, (S) special training facilities, (T) unidentified facilities or tracking activity.




FIGURE 1. RYAZAN ARMY BARRACKS SOUTHWEST.

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SUMMARY

Ryazan Army Barracks Southwest is located in the southwestern part of Ryazan (Figure 1).

The installation covers approximately 1,200 acres and contains 5 administration buildings, 1 probable administration building, 9 barracks/administration buildings, 25 probable barracks, 12 probable quarters, 27 storage buildings, 2 revetted explosives storage buildings, 3 equipment/vehicle maintenance buildings, 2 probable transloading buildings, 54 support buildings, and 2 athletic fields (Figures 2 and 3).

A training area is located in the southern part of the installation and occupies approximately 900 acres. It contains 5 small-arms firing ranges, 2 wheeled-vehicle driver-training courses, and 6 support buildings.

The installation is covered on 7 KEYHOLE missions between June 1963 and December 1964. Comparative analysis reveals no apparent change in facilities and a moderate level of activity during the period.

DESCRIPTION OF INSTALLATION

Railroad Service

The installation is served by a spur from the Ryazan-Ryazhsk rail line.

Road Service

Ryazan streets provide access to the installation.

Administrative and Troop Housing Area

Area D contains 5 administration buildings, 9 barracks/administration buildings, 25 probable barracks, 12 probable quarters, and 26 support buildings.

General Storage Area

Area E contains 21 storage buildings and 2 probable transloading buildings.

Explosives Storage Area

Area Γ contains 2 revetted explosives storage buildings and 5 support buildings.

Other Buildings

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Area H2 probably supports Area J1 and contains 2 secured storage buildings and 4 support buildings.

Equipment Storage/Maintenance Areas

Area J1 contains 1 equipment/vehicle maintenance shed, approximately 200 by 35 feet, 1 probable administration building, 4 storage buildings, and 8 support buildings.

Area J2 contains 2 long equipment/vehicle maintenance sheds, each approximately 400 by 45 feet, and 3 support buildings.

Athletic Fields

Areas K1 and K2 are athletic fields.

Small-Arms Firing Ranges

Area L1 is a small-arms firing range (375 by 150 feet).


Areas L2-L5 are small-arms firing ranges (325 by 200 feet).

Driver-Training Areas

Areas M1 and M2 contain wheeled-vehicle driver-training courses.
