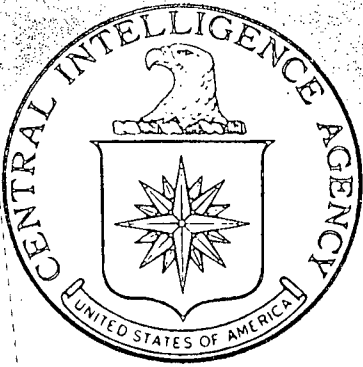

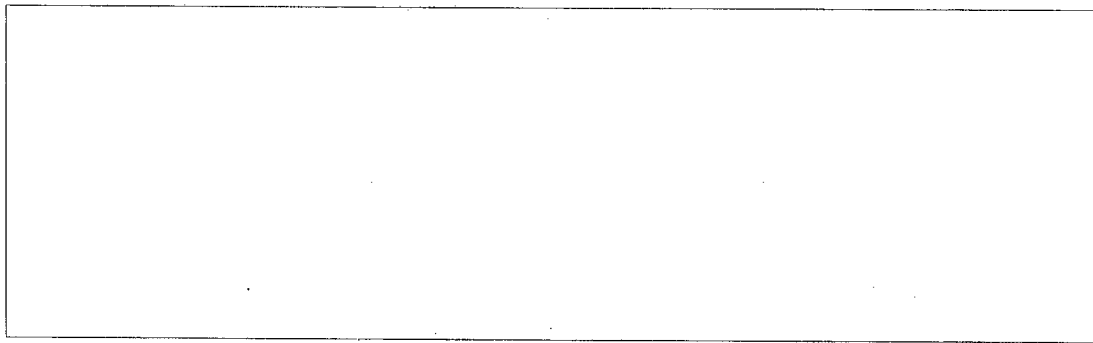

 2. Lower case letters (i.e., Ba) are used to delineate more than one area of a particular functional category.
 3. Numbers are used with the alphabetical designators in some instances to identify vehicles or groups of vehicles within a functional area (i.e., Ba 1).

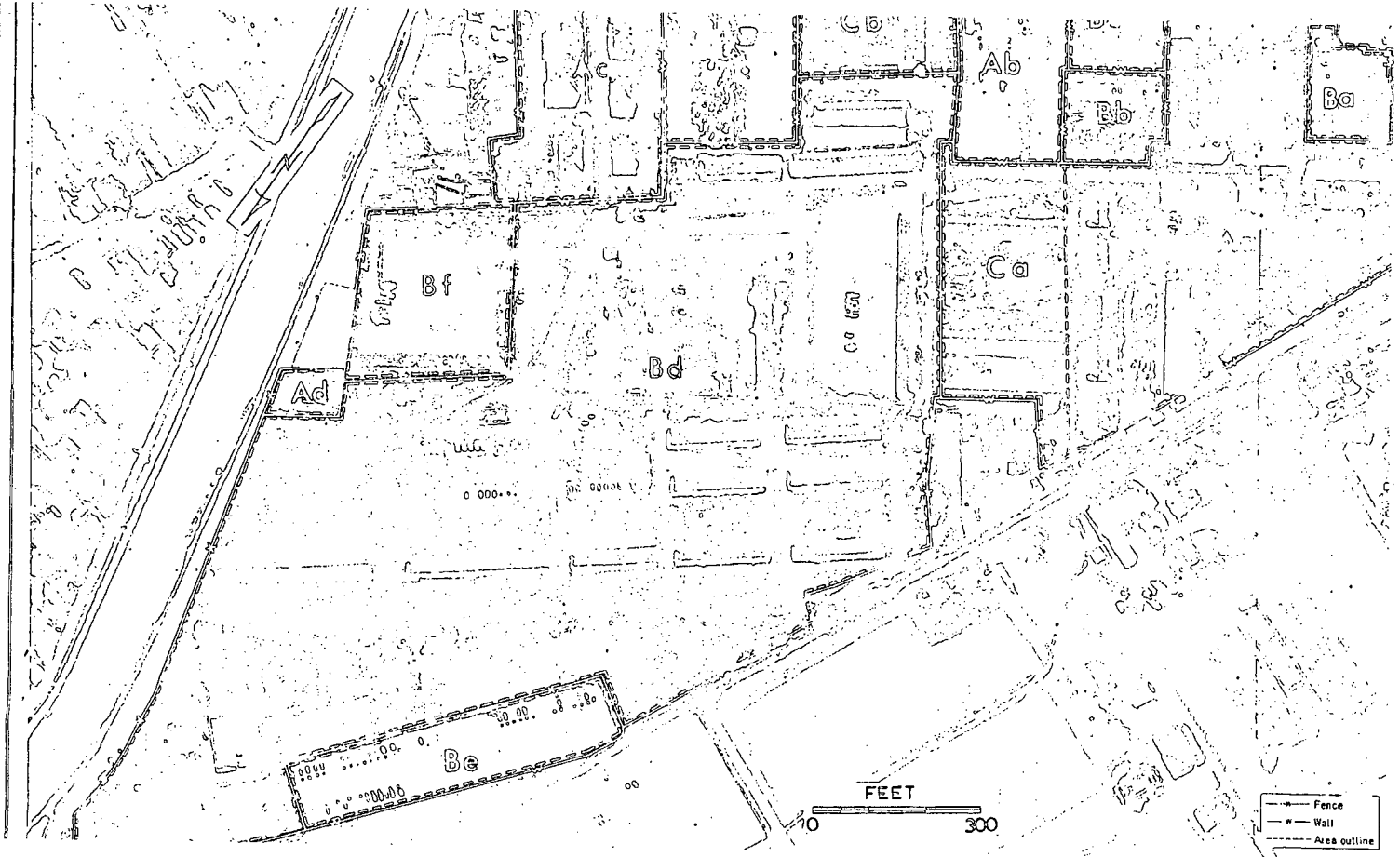

PI COMMENTS

Uzhgorod Army Barracks AL-1 is covered on clear, good quality photography. Other facilities observed and not mentioned elsewhere include an obstacle course in area Aa, grease racks in areas Be, and Bd, and a parade ground in area Aa. Of special significance is the separately wall secured motor pools Bb and Bc. The vehicle/equipment sheds are wider and shorter than those observed in normal vehicle parks. The location of a suspect missile transporter in area Bc may indicate the presence of a tactical missile unit.
