AT 0930 THIS MORNING FAR EAST PILOTS ASSUUFGPINFORMED AIR AMERICA TH T ITS WENBERS WOULD GO ON STRIKE MIDNIGHT JANUARY 23-24 LOCAL TIME. SO INFORMED ME THIS MORNING AND AT 1230 LOCAL. WITH CHIEF AIR SUPPORT BRANCH OF USAID, I MET WITH CAPTAIN RICHARD STEWART FROM VIENTIANE AND CAPTAIN FOOT FROM LD OR N WHO GAVE ME A LETTER OF TODAY'S DATE SIGNED BY E.P. SCHNEIDER, PRESIDENT, FEPA, INFORMING ME THAT DUE TO DEADLOCK ON TWO ISSUES UNDER NEGOTIATION WITH THE COMPANY THE FEPA BOARD OF DIRECTORS BELIEVES "INDUSTRIAL ACTION MAY SOON BE IN ORDER AND NECESSARY TO GET THE NEGOTIATIONS UNDERWAY AGAIN." LETTER CONTINUES "AS A POSSIBILITY NOW EXISTS THAT ALL CUSTOMERS COULD BE DIRECTLY AFFECTED BY SUCH ACTION, I WOUL LIKE TO MAKE IT CLEAR THAT THOSE FLIGHTS OF AN EMERGENCY NATURE INVOLVING HUMAN LIFE WILL BE FLOWN." CAPTAIN STEWART SAID THAT STRIKE WAS BEING CALLED AS OF MIDNIGHT TOMORROW NIGHT.

EXPRESSED THE PERSONAL HOPE THAT MATTERS COULD BE SATISFACTORILY ARRANGED WITH COMPANY AND SAID THAT I COULD NOT REPEAT NOT TAKE SIDES IN THIS ISSUE. I ADDED HOWEVER THAT IN VIEW OF THE LOCAL MILITARY SITUATION THESE WERE DIFFICULT TIMES AND MY JT WAS TO SEE TO IT THAT ASSISTANCE TO HE RLG CONTINUED.
