MEMORANDUM FOR: Director of Central Intelligence

Sir:

- 1. An Air America Volpar, is overdue and missing in a flight from Midway to Adak. The plane was being ferried from Tainan to Roswell, New Mexico, which is the marshaling point of the remaining Air America aircraft.
- The ferrying operation is being conducted under contract with a Los Angeles based flying concern. The plane, however, is an acknowledged Air America aircraft and its filing of flight plans so acknowledges.
- 3. Appropriate air and sea rescue entities have been alerted and appropriate searches are underway. There is only one personnel aboard the plane.
- 4. I have alerted Mr. Dennis Berend, Deputy Assistant to the DCI, and told him that if he is in receipt of any inquiries to refer the inquirer to the Air America Washington Office.
- 5. From a realistic point of view, there is practically no hope of pilot survival, and little more of locating the aircraft.
